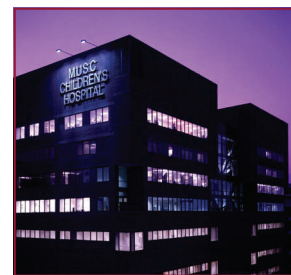

Dr. Kathy Chessman has been the Clinical Pharmacy Specialist providing both pharmacy- and nutrition-related services for the Pediatric Burn Service at MUSC since 1987. Kathy received a B.S. degree in Biology from Presbyterian College and B.S. and Pharm.D degrees from the MUSC College of Pharmacy. She completed a residency in Pediatric Pharmacotherapy and Nutrition at LeBonheur Children's Medical Center in Memphis, Tennessee.

Besides her burn team role, Kathy is the clinical pharmacy specialist for Pediatric Surgery and provides pharmacy services to General Pediatrics patients as well. Dr. Chessman is also a Professor with tenure in the Department of Clinical Pharmacy and Outcome Sciences in the South Carolina College of Pharmacy and the Residency Program Director for the PGY2 Pediatric Pharmacy Residency program.

Dr. Chessman has published a number of articles and book chapters related to pediatric nutrition and the care of children with burns. In 2000, she received the inaugural MUSC Outstanding Clinician Award for her patient care service in the MUSC Children's Hospital.

In her spare time, Kathy likes gardening and reading and rings hand bells for her church. Her husband, Alec, is a member of the MUSC Department of Family Medicine faculty. She has two children: Hannah, a junior at Virginia Tech majoring in Interior Design; and Zachary, a sophomore at Academic Magnet High School interested in computers.

## Make your Summer Safe: Outdoor Burn Injury Prevention

- **Caution around campfires: Create a Circle of Safety with rocks or bricks around the fire**
- **Clean outdoor grills of grease build-up and use lighter fluid sparingly**
- **Use gasoline carefully when filling your lawnmower**
- **Caution with hot radiators**
- **Use sunblock (SPF 30 or above) when outdoors**
- **Supervise children around fireworks: Go to a professional display!**
- **When traveling, know hotel and motel exits and identify fire alarms & safety equipment**
